CMD's Message

It is with mixed feelings that I pen down this month's message to you. Even as I write, rescuers fear hypothermia in people stuck inside the Tapovan tunnel as they race against time to take them out. Around 30-35 people may be stuck inside the tunnel as on date. Slush and water coming from inside the tunnel has made rescue efforts even more tedious.

As you know, the sudden flood in the Alaknanda river system in Uttarakhand's Chamoli district on Sunday was caused when a portion of the Nanda Devi glacier broke off early on 7 February,

releasing the water trapped behind the ice in a glacial lake. The cause for the glacier falling apart may be due to climate change or as a result of construction projects in the area.

I would like to point out here that the biggest concern in the current times, is preservation of mother nature. I think we are being sent enough signals to hold our wild horses, reorient our ambitions in terms of industrialization / modernization and give nature a chance to breathe. One of the biggest lessons we learnt through the pandemic is that this planet does not need us, it's rather the other way around. We are guests on this planet, nature has been immensely kind and generous to us and it's important for us to respect and appreciate that, instead of plundering its bounty.

With these words and a prayer in my heart for all those who have been hit by the Uttarakhand tragedy, I sign off today.
